

Tracey Miller-Zarneke Gets Animated About Her Career and Community Involvement

Well-known in town for her roles as a member of both the School Board and Environmental Committee, Tracey Miller-Zarneke is arguably more famous outside of El Segundo for her lengthy and diverse entertainment industry career and especially since 2007 as the author of 14 "art of" books in support of some of the most acclaimed animated films of this era. The list of her notable "art of" tomes include the Kung Fu Panda and Cloudy with a Chance of Meatballs series, among others. The books offer fascinating behind-the-scenes looks at character designs and art concepts from said movies. And when your vocation also allows you to hang out with the likes of Sting or fly to Copenhagen for speaking engagements, you might just be tempted to note that you've got a "pretty cool career" going. But for the long-time localresident, job success doesn't hold a candle to achievements of a more personal nature. "I am most grateful for the quality time my work has allowed me to spend with family and my community and the many amazing people I have met along the way who have become treasured friends and colleagues," Miller-Zarneke said.

Born and raised in New Jersey, Miller-Zarneke (nee Tracey Miller) was relieved her parents tired of the East Coast's frigid winters and opted to move to Southern California when she was nine. The family settled in Fountain Valley, and she eventually attended UCLA, where she earned a degree in English/American Studies in 1992. Not long after, she met her future husband, Mike Zarneke, and the couple moved to El Segundo 27 years ago. "It was not only

to be near the beach and be accessible to our places of employment, but also to be in a nice community with an excellent school district as we knew raising children would be in our future," she said. During that period, she commuted to Burbank for a position at Walt Disney Feature Animation. Traffic on the 105 was still fairly manageable then, making the ride time decidedly more reasonable than it is nowadays.

Miller-Zarneke always found animation enthralling. One of her first jobs during college was in the shops in Tomorrowland at Disneyland. She loved it there, but also accepted some "less inspiring" gigs at various software and insurance firms to make ends meet. While studying in Westwood, she met a group of

ambitious women who were part of the "Bruin Belles" community service organization on the campus. This involvement sparked a lifelong passion for volunteerism and leadership. Also, it helped kickstart her "official career" that began at a public relations boutique in Beverly Hills, first as an intern and then account executive with The Donahue Group. She next joined the National Publicity Department for Buena Vista Pictures Marketing at Walt Disney Studios, leading to a stint in production management on The Emperor's New Groove and Chicken Little. Early career highlights included work on the film campaigns for The Lion King and Toy Story, and she was also part of the team that oversaw


The Collected Regrets of Clover by Mikki Brammer

Death, for most people, is an uncomfortable topic of conversation. In the United States, most employees are given a two-week bereavement period. After that, the employee is expected to report back to work and function as if their heart is not broken. Realistically, grieving is a unique experience, and the pain never truly goes away.

In this fiction debut novel, named one of the best books of 2023 by NPR, the author gives the reader an intimate portrayal of grief and the unique grieving process. We are introduced to Clover, the main character, as a young girl. She witnesses the untimely tragic death of her kindergarten teacher during Storytime and instead of being fearful she is intrigued. The authors description of Clover viewing the body in a curious way is not macabre. Just an innocent first brush with death. Clover does not have friends at school and after this event with her teacher and her reaction to the event, she becomes even more of an outcast. Clovers young life is impacted yet again when her parents die unexpectedly. She is an only child and is sent to live with her grandfather in New York City. She loves her grandfather dearly and spends many years bonding with him. Then, while traveling as a young adult, her beloved grandfather dies alone.

This is just too much for Clover and she decides to spend the rest of her life making

sure people do not die alone and becomes a death doula. She keeps journals of her clients dying words and refers to them often for comfort. Her heart is still broken from all her losses and she craves companionship, but at the same time she prefers to stay in her grandfather's furnished apartment, watching rom-coms and living a vicarious life through her neighbors. She is much more comfortable around those who are breathing their last breath than those who have many more breath filled days ahead. Her sole hobby is attending numerous Death Cafes around New York where attendees share stories about death, asking the moderator questions and finding some solace in the journey

At one of these cafes Clover meets a young man, Sebastian, and suddenly Clovers quiet controlled life takes an unexpected turn. Does she continue letting grief plan out her days or does she decide to walk side by side with grief; acknowledging it's existence but at the same time choosing to live?

I completely enjoyed getting to know all the characters in this book and even though the subject matter is dark the book itself is not a sad tale. It did not feel like a depressing read to me. It is ultimately a book of hope, second chances, acceptance, and love. A quote from the book that resonated with me is "Grief is just love looking for a place to settle." This book would make a great book club pick and could possibly lead to conversations surrounding grief, healing and the stigma of discussing death.

New Era Begins for Football Team

The El Segundo high school football program enters a new era by hiring a new football head coach. After Shawn Green, who led the Eagles for three seasons, stepped down, an exhaustive search to find the Eagles' new head coach was started. The process was narrowed down to a final choice and Rory Schoonmaker was selected. If his name isn't familiar now, it will be. He will be teaching physical education at El Segundo Middle School. He has taught physical education for the last eight years and formerly was the P.E. department chair at Santa Ana High School.

Rory's got plenty of experience both as a player and as a coach. It is in his blood and it was a family affair growing up. "I played, my brother played, dad coached, sister cheered and mom oversaw all of it." When he wasn't on the field playing, he was in the street in front of his house playing, and when he was in the house, he was watching games. He played six years of youth football and stood out during his freshman season at Garden Grove H.S. in Garden Grove, where he grew up. After his freshman year, his family moved to Huntington Beach, where he went on to play for the Huntington Beach H.S. Oilers for the next three seasons. After graduating from Huntington Beach High, he played at Santa Ana Community College, where he was fortunate enough to earn a scholarship. He played his junior and senior years of college at Graceland University in Iowa.

After college, he started his coaching career at Edison High School, a perennial Orange County powerhouse. "Coming out of college, I got an outstanding opportunity to coach at Edison High School for Coach Dave White,

who had an enormous influence on my coaching career," Rory says. Coach White was vital in his development as a coach and painted a very clear picture of what a quality program should look like. "My biggest influence in terms of coaching has always been my father," Rory says. His father, Dan, is the head football coach for Bainbridge Island High School in Washington.

There have been other influences in Rory's coaching career; they have been stalwart and highly regarded coaches. "I have tried to learn from every head coach I have worked with." He says to their credit, they all did an amazing job of letting him grow as an assistant coach in their programs. Many of those guys like "Coach Charlie Tegantvoort (currently the head coach at Marina High) and Mike Ogas (former Canyon High head coach) I consider great friends and successful coaches I can get advice from"

Rory's coaching resume speaks for itself. He has coached football for the last 15 years at the community college and high school level. Through his 13-year high school coaching career he has have won seven league championships and never missed the CIF playoffs. Additionally, he has also coached in five CIF semi-final games (Edison, Canyon, Santa Ana) and two CIF Championship games (Edison - 2009 and Canyon 2015) and won a CIF title with Canyon (2015).

With his recipe for success during his coaching career, what inspired Rory to be interested in the head coaching position for the Eagles? He says he moved to the South Bay area five years ago. Since then, he has gotten married and started a family and is the proud father of a little boy. "Except for my





job, my entire life had been moved up to the South Bay." He continued, "I want my family to be a presence wherever I teach and coach, so I think it was only a matter of time before I made the transition up here."

Rory says he was really waiting for the right opportunity, and when he saw the El Segundo job open, he knew it was the one. "I had an opportunity to experience the character, community, and energy of El Segundo as an opponent in a CIF playoff game at Hazeltine Field in 2016. It was a great game that was decided in the last 90 seconds." The Eagles defeated the defending CIF champion Canyon (Anaheim) Comanches 17-10.

What impressed Rory were the emotions of the game. "It's easy for kids, coaches, and fans to get carried away. The class and sportsmanship were demonstrated by the community of El Segundo and their football program and staff." He says that experience has always stuck with him. "I have always considered ESHS a quality football program with a strong, supportive community that preaches character. I certainly jumped at the opportunity to be a part of that."

Rory left as head coach of an impressive Santa Ana Saints program and two-time defending Orange Coast League champions to come to El Segundo. So, stepping into a new environment could've been a true challenge, but Rory has uniquely solidified his standing with the players. He considers himself a reasonably energetic person with some skills outside of your typical head coach. "I think the most significant characteristic to have as a coaching general is strong interpersonal communication skills. I would like to think that is one of my strengths." He says he equates that to being able to communicate positively with players. He continued, "Breaking down and delivering information that they can retain individually, build positive relationships, and help guide them to success both on and off the field."

Naming Rory Schoomaker as the new football head coach wasn't announced until May. Most schools had been having spring workouts, but El Segundo was in search of a new face for the program. So, how does a new head coach get his players to gain their confidence in such a short time? He worked very hard through the end of spring and into the summer on developing individual relationships with players and introducing and emphasizing the program's core principles. "Working to set

a strong foundation and getting to know the players individually has allowed us to grow together through the late transition over the last two and a half months."

Some head coaches are defensive-minded minded and some are offensively gifted coaches. Rory was a quarterback in high school and college so he will probably call the offense. "I have definitely made my mark as an offensive coordinator." With his football I.Q., knowledge, and a good understanding of the game, he could call the defense. He says, "Though most of my experience has been coaching the offensive side of the ball, I expanded my defensive scheme knowledge last year as a head coach (at Santa Ana high school) and have worked to continue to do so this offseason."

Rory says he has not set any personal goals other than preparing his team each week. But he says, "The team goal is always the same: to win a CIF championship. Sometimes, the most difficult part with setting that high bar is getting the kids to believe they can do it." He believes building confidence will result from players understanding the value of their role within the team dynamics and teaching the "why" behind their assignments and execution. He added, "After all, it is difficult to take pride in your work or be confident in your execution if you don't know why what you're doing, individually, is significant to accomplishing the task."

How does a new coach prepare his team for the rigors of a football season? He says, "While it will probably look different in the future, we have kept to ourselves for the most part this offseason." The Eagles have gone to one passing and lineman competition where they got great work against quality teams. The work's primary emphasis was installing the base offensive and defensive packages. "The kids have done great, and it is a hungry group that wants to learn."

So, a new football era begins for the Eagles with Rory Schoomaker at the helm. He said, "I would love to thank all of the individuals who have reached out to welcome me to the district and the community. I am extremely proud to represent El Segundo with energy, enthusiasm, and professionalism. I hope to see everyone in the stands on Friday nights!"



the premiere showing of *Pocahontas* in front of 100,000 attendees in Central Park. On the side, she helped produce a documentary about animation production entitled *The Sweatbox* (produced by Sting's wife, Trudie Styler). She later provided research material for another documentary—*Waking Sleeping Beauty*. Oh, and she also managed to land a small speaking role in *Meet the Robinsons*.

Miller-Zarneke had a difficult decision to make when she and her husband were ready to start a family. To reprioritize her time, she shifted away from production to writing. "I figured out a way to combine my extensive PR writing practice and firsthand animation production experience and how to do most of my work while the kids were in school or sleeping," she said. This led to the "art of" collections and additional textbooks on the history and production of animation. She also serves as the Chair of Legacy Archives for the advocacy group Women in Animation

and as a press materials writer and panel moderator for several studios and animation organizations. "Now that my two boys are grown and I have more flexibility on my calendar, my career has expanded further, broadened beyond the animation realm to include strategic communications for school districts, cities and other public entities... a perfect way to combine my community service experience gained at El Segundo Unified School District as a governing School Board member the last six years and with the City of El Segundo as the Environmental Committee Chair since 2016," she said.

Miller-Zarneke pointed out that her worlds collide in positive and constructive ways, as her book projects promote dialogue with local students—particularly during College and Career Day events at El Segundo High School. "They help me speak to what it means to be a writer, how to be self-driven, what careers in the animation industry might be appealing

to our students, and a broader degree, what it means to appreciate history, to respect other people's creative visions and how to work well as a team player," she said.

As for creative vision, Miller-Zarneke fully embraces the pathway from onset to completion. She admits she used to find it daunting—especially when a deadline flashed before her eyes—but now looks at the task of filling the page as a "fun game of dialing in and delivering the right tone to the right audience." She added, "When it's a film-related book project, I really enjoy the energy of the artist talking about their creative process, channeling that energy in a similar way when I help tell their story or, in textbook projects, when I help explain a complex process in an easy-to-comprehend way."

Miller-Zarneke was pleased to report that her latest book, The Art of Kung Fu Panda 4, just came out last month. Next up is Marvel Studios: 100 Objects, set to hit the shelves/

Amazon virtual store in early October. "But what is reallykeeping me busy at the moment are a half-dozen clients who have bond measures on the November ballot up and down the state," she said.

Carving her freelance resume opened other more rewarding avenues in the long run."
