Council Passes Balanced Budget; Special Olympics Torch Relay Will Pass Through Lawndale

With a new fiscal year rapidly approaching, the Lawndale City Council took measures Monday to insure the city's continuing financial health, passing a balanced budget. Also on agenda were the 2016-17 budgets for the Lawndale Housing Authority and Cable Usage Corporation and the Redevelopment Successor Agency. All budgets were passed with unanimous approval.

City Manager Steve Mandoki detailed additional items discussed at the May 9 budget workshop. Under council direction, funding for a concrete grinder was incorporated into the budget, and a surplus of \$50,000 was allocated for additional staffing at Hopper Park. Mandoki noted more discussion would be needed on resources for a natural gas fueling station, an unfunded project. In addition, the \$100,000 cost for an electronic marquee will need to come from reserves.

The Consent Calendar included 11 items and was passed in totality. Contracts for citywide concrete repairs, tree trimming services, as well as landscaping and other claims and demands netted a total bill of just under \$1.9 million.

In other business, the council opened a public hearing on adoption of the LA County fee schedule for building and safety codes. Mandoki noted this action will update codes existing for several decades, and will represent \$175,000 in savings. With the close of public comments, the measure was passed unanimously.

Mayor Robert Pullen-Miles previewed a proposal from LA County to pursue funding to address homelessness. He received a letter requesting support for a future ballot measure seeking a 1 percent sales tax increase. "It's a good idea," Pullen-Miles said. "We need to see the details, but we can, at least, have a discussion." Council Member Dan Reid agreed, saying, "This is a chance to ask the electorate."

Applicants for city advisory committees were invited to introduce themselves and make comments at will. Several community members cited their previous service to the city and desire to continue. Pullen-Miles expressed the council's gratitude for their role in the shared governance of Lawndale. The mayor's recommendations for approved unanimously.

Appointees to the 2016-17 Planning Commission are as follows: Pedro Cordova, Sirley Cuevas, John Martinez, Uffe Moller and Scott Smith. Appointees to the Beautification Committee are: Charmaine Doty, Karen Escamilla, Olga Sierra Gonzalez, Douglas Keyser, Martin Martinez, Judy Oldziewski and Marco Sandoval.

Mr. Mandoki introduced newly hired Director of Community Development, Sean Moore.

The mayor asked staff to begin looking at potential tourism opportunities as a result of the new NFL, L.A. Rams franchise coming to Inglewood. "This is a regional event," Pullen-Miles said. "It will bring economic opportunity to this whole area."

The safety report was presented by Lieutenant Hocking. In the previous two weeks, several arrests were made. A suspect was arrested for vandalism after being identified using a baseball bat to shatter a window at Wiener Schnitzel on Hawthorne. A license plate run turned up a vehicle stolen from the Inglewood area. The car contained methamphetamine and other drug paraphernalia.

A patrol check in the 4500 block of Artesia, in response to complaints of bad odors and waste accumulating, turned up a vacant carport being used by transients in possession of heroin, meth and numerous syringes. A man was apprehended near Hawthorne and 162nd in possession of a 32-caliber hand gun with serial numbers removed. "These kinds of arrests keep shootings from occurring,"

Hocking said.

Public comments turned to crime and unseemly behavior, particularly in Hopper Park. Reports of drinking, drug usage and loud vulgar music are commonplace. Earl Wood, who lives near the park, said, "My house has been burglarized. The residents are suffering."

Pam London said she comes to the council repeatedly to bring issues and solutions. "We should take a look at Upland. They have a policy on weed abatement."

Council Member Pat Kearney pointed to the budget initiative to provide immediate staffing for Hopper. Ms. L. Unruh said she is thrilled there is a budget to staff the park.

The entire council attended the Memorial Day Breakfast last week, giving staff kudos for planning the event. "The new breakfast format was fantastic," Kearney said. Reid said that the local veterans who came out were very thankful.

Lieutenant Hocking announced the Special Olympics Torch Relay will pass through the city on June 10 at approximately 10 a.m. Lawndale will receive the torch from Hawthorne Police Department at Hawthorne Boulevard and Rosecrans, and pass it to Rosecrans Police Department at Manhattan Beach Boulevard and Crenshaw Boulevard. He encouraged the community to come out.

The council voted to cancel a calendared Tuesday, July 5 meeting, as the regularly scheduled Monday meeting fell on the national holiday of July 4. The Lawndale City Council will reconvene its normal bi-monthly schedule as of July 18.

Mayor Pullen-Miles asked that the meeting be adjourned in the memory of Adolph Moran, a long-time resident of the city, who passed away recently.

The next meeting of the Lawndale City Council will be held at 6:30 p.m. on Monday, June 20 at Lawndale City Hall. •

Planet 1,200 Light-Years Away Is **Good Prospect for a Habitable World**

A distant planet known as Kepler-62f could be habitable, a team of astronomers reports.

The planet, which is about 1,200 light-years from Earth in the direction of the constellation Lyra, is approximately 40 percent larger than Earth. At that size, Kepler-62f is within the range of planets that are likely to be rocky and possibly could have oceans, said Aomawa Shields, the study's lead author and a National Science Foundation astronomy and astrophysics postdoctoral fellow in UCLA's department of physics and astronomy.

NASA's Kepler mission discovered the planetary system that includes Kepler-62f in 2013, and it identified Kepler-62f as the outermost of five planets orbiting a star that is smaller and cooler than the sun. But the mission didn't produce information about Kepler-62f's composition or atmosphere or the shape of its orbit.

Shields collaborated on the study with astronomers Rory Barnes, Eric Agol, Benjamin Charnay, Cecilia Bitz and Victoria Meadows, all of the University of Washington, where Shields earned her doctorate. To determine whether the planet could sustain life, the team came up with possible scenarios about what its atmosphere might be like and what the shape of its orbit might be.

"We found there are multiple atmospheric compositions that allow it to be warm enough to have surface liquid water," Shields said. "This makes it a strong candidate for a habitable planet."

On Earth, carbon dioxide makes up 0.04 percent of the atmosphere. Because Kepler-62f is much farther away from its star than Earth is from the Sun, it would need to have dramatically more carbon dioxide to be warm enough to maintain liquid water on its surface.

The team ran computer simulations based on Kepler-62f having:

An atmosphere that ranges in thickness from the same as Earth's all the way up to 12 times thicker.

Various concentrations of carbon dioxide in its atmosphere, ranging from the same amount as is in the Earth's atmosphere up to 2,500 times that level. Several different possible orbital paths.

Shields said that for the planet to be habitable throughout its entire year, it would require an atmosphere that is three to five times thicker than Earth's and composed entirely of carbon dioxide. (This would be analogous to replacing every molecule in Earth's atmosphere with carbon dioxide, which means that the planet would have 2,500 times more carbon dioxide than we have.

"But if it doesn't have a mechanism to generate lots of carbon dioxide in its atmosphere to keep temperatures warm, and all it had was an Earth-like amount of carbon dioxide, certain orbital configurations could allow Kepler-62f's surface temperatures to temporarily get above freezing during a portion of its year," she said. "And this might help melt ice sheets formed at other times in the planet's orbit."

The research is published online in the journal Astrobiology.

Shields earned a master's degree in acting from UCLA and worked as an actor. In January 2015, she founded Rising Stargirls, a program that teaches middle school-aged girls of color about astronomy and astrobiology using theater, writing and visual art. 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Hawthorne Math & Science Academy Seniors Earn Gates Millennium Scholarship

Working hard is nothing new for Hawthorne Math & Science Academy seniors Johann Webb and Isaac Gorgy: 4.0 GPAs, Advanced Placement courses and volunteering for various activities are just some of the accolades on their high school record. Recently added to that list are recipients of the Gates Millennium Scholarship.

"I wasn't expecting to get it at all; I had a certain percent chance that I wasn't going to get this scholarship," Gorgy said. "There are so many people that applied, so why would they chose me? It is hard to describe but it was something that I never imagine getting it."

Funded through a \$1.6 billion donation from the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation, the GMS was awarded to 1,000 high school seniors throughout the United States. The scholarship, which aims to promote "academic excellence and to provide an opportunity for outstanding minority students with significant financial need to reach their highest potential" funds the undergraduate, graduate and even Ph.D education of the recipients. The demanding application process was something that Gorgy and Webb expected but admit that applying for this scholarship was unlike applying for any other scholarship.

"It [GMS] was not something that was unknown to us but our counselor, Ms. Bui, brought it to us and said that we should really

apply," Webb said. "She mentioned how they really stressed volunteering so we had to make sure to prepare for that, as well as the eight essays that they required: there were eight essays and I had probably written that many applying to colleges."

With the help of their counselor Julia Bui, the two young academics went step-by-step through the application process, multiple times, ensuring that no detail was missed while simultaneously encouraging the two seniors to keep pushing forward.

"Before speaking to Ms. Bui I didn't think this scholarship was something tangible for people like us, but she stressed it, she gave us the prompts and vetted us through it," said Gorgy. "It was definitely overwhelming. Looking at the prompt you realize how much they require of you and at one time I did think it was too much and that I probably wouldn't get it but I had so many people supporting me that I kept me going."

After submitting the application in January both students went on with other senior-year activities, including applying for additional scholarships for financial assistance. It wasn't until March that they learned they had been selected as finalist to receive the scholarship.

"That is when I thought I really had a chance at this and that I could be set for life," Webb said.

In April the two busy teens received the package that would change their lives in the

"I was at home and I don't remember if I had a good or bad day but I had a really bad headache," Webb, who is planning to attend UC San Diego to major in engineering, said. "I was lying down in bed and was trying to go to sleep but my sister was bugging me. She then said 'some mail from the gates millennial scholarship came' to which I said okay but she told me it was a package. At that point my headache started to go away."

Both students were spending time and energy applying for other scholarships but now that's over.

"I was walking home from school. My parents saw the envelope and didn't want to open it so they left it for me on the table to see when I walked in," Gorgy, who will attend UCLA to major in Biology, said. "I think they had a feeling what it was since it was a fancy and very professional envelope. Opening it was the ultimate ecstasy. It was a feeling you can't describe. I thought I would scream at the top of my lungs but I was speechless."

In addition to the financial amenities, the scholarship connects the students to a community of scholars so that they do not just become college students going through the motions. The network of fellow academics

that they are connected to is expected to tailor leaders that engage in activities beyond academics.

"It [GMS] lets you focus on your education because now you don't have to worry about money, a job; your focus is on your goal," Gorgy said. "That is the most incredible part about this scholarship."

Both students acknowledged that without the impact of HMSA, its teachers and counselors, their accomplishments would not have been possible.

"You could teach yourself if you have that inner motivation and it can take you far but there is no substitute for a good teacher," Webb said. "This school is full of great teachers. They are inspirational themselves and come with great backgrounds."

In order to apply for the scholarship a student must have a nominator and recommender who are asked extensive questions, with much detail.

"Without my nominator and recommender, I would not have applied at all. Ms. Bui, our counselor, and Ms. Sharp, my world history teacher, were my biggest influences in participating," Gorgy said. "I genuinely would not have applied if it weren't for them and their constant encouragement. The spotlight is on us but the credit is all theirs because I owe it all to them." •


foster mother picked up off the street. Dolly is a sweetheart and very entertaining as well as being a wonderful companion and playmate to her foster kitty sisters.
