

Weekend Forecast began in a space of about 2,000 square feet. "It was bare bones - the minimum. Whatever we could find, be it donated equipment or punching bags. The hard part was finding a boxing ring. I was the main one pushing forward, leading the charge, the one to sign the lease. I also was working full time. Around 4 pm, after I got done at my job, I would

get to the gym, and be there until 10 pm. That went on for seven years, juggling a whole lot of things. We were not making money, but now, 15 years later, here we are in almost 8,000 square feet, with two boxing rings and more equipment than we know what to do with. We are open six days a week. The gym is a USA Boxing member, licensed through the California State Athletic Commission." Marco Trejo grew up in Hawthorne. Well, perhaps "grew up" is a bit of an exaggeration. He attended a few of our local high schools, including Hawthorne High, back in the day. His academics and behavior were not what you would call "exemplary." There were distractions and bad influences. There was trouble, if you were not disciplined. It was easy to stray off the good path. Marco's dad also was one of his biggest challenges. A tough guy, to be sure, but as fate would have it, during the last two years of Dad's life, as the gym began to flourish, as the work and sweat literally began to pay off, father and son found common ground through boxing, with dad helping at the gym. Since Marco Sr. loved boxing and introduced

"Just as the business began taking shape, Dad was diagnosed with cancer. He died three months later. In all my life, he told me two things that have really stuck. First, when I was a teenager, he reminded me how I like to start things but never finish them. I took that as an insult, although it was true. I understood that not finishing was a disappointment to him as well as to myself. Just before Dad died, maybe three days before, his last words to me were: 'Son, you don't give up on me...' I know what he was telling me. He meant, no matter how tough things get, don't quit, give it everything you got, which is how I am living today." Marco's transformation from an errant kid to a responsible adult is one of the reasons why this story, the reality and success of Sweet "We're motivated to inspire and to help people get in shape. Our bread and butter, what we are known for, is boxing, but we also teach self-defense, martial arts, physical fitness, wrestling, and kickboxing. We have 15 employees on staff, which includes trainers and management. I see kids who do not have a dad in their lives or some who are from an unstable home. They come to the gym shy and unsure of themselves. Somebody brings them, maybe a grandparent or brother, and they make friends, gain muscle, and hold their heads higher. We teach them discipline, the value of hard work, and, more importantly, respect. In the boxing gym, respect is earned, not given. It is a special kind of respect. 
Stars and Smoke by Marie Lu

Marie Lu is a Young Adult fantasy/science fiction writer who wrote the Legend, Young Elites and Skyhunter series. When I saw the book Stars and Smoke, I knew I had to read it. Marie Lu's books always have a good plot and great characters. Having not read the book jacket, I was expecting another science fiction book. Imagine my surprise when it turned out to be a spy novel! This is the first book in the series. The next book, Icon and Inferno, comes out in June. Winter Young, a Chinese American young adult, is one of the biggest pop stars on the planet. He used to be a backup dancer before hitting it big and now is an international rock star. I think of him being a cross between Taylor Swift and Justin Bieber. Because of his superstar status, Winter is recruited by the covert ops organization Panacea Group. They want to catch international tycoon Eli Morrison but he proves to be too slippery and slick. His only weakness is his daughter, Penelope. She is turning 19, the same age as Winter and wants to have a private concert. The Panacea Group persuades Winter to help them out and teach him some survival skills before performing for Penelope. They have a secret agent, Sydney Cossette, who is also 19 and is the perfect cover as Winter's bodyguard.

Sydney doesn't have any family. Her mother died and her father was abusive, so Sydney decided to make the Panacea Group her family, particularly her handlers, Sauda and Niall. They substitute as surrogate parents to Sydney and help her out of tough situations. After training Winter to handle himself in case

something goes wrong during their operation, Winter and Sydney go to London to fulfill their mission. At first, Sydney is resentful of Winter and thinks that he is just a pretty face and one dimensional. As she gets to know him, Sydney discovers that there is a lot of depth to Winter and he has a hidden agenda. Winter is famous and popular, but is also lonely. He doesn't have many true friends and is not close to his mother. His older halfbrother, Artie, worked in the Peace Corps and was killed. Their mother fell apart after Artie died and completely ignored Winter. One of the reasons Winter agreed to work for Panacea Group is he wanted to find out what really happened to Artie. Did he really work for the Peace Corp? Was he a secret undercover spy? These burning questions fuel Winter and make him want to bring down Eli Morrison and his illegal arms operation.

The action really starts building up when Winter and Sydney arrive in London. They scope out the party location and try to plan for any eventuality. As the concert nears, Winter and Sydney grow closer. They both get to use their skills and try to catch Eli and his associates before the arms deal is completed. Some complications arise when the concert for Penelope starts. Who are the ones wanting to buy the weapons? Does Penelope really have a boyfriend? Will Winter and Sydney be able to escape the dangers that surround them? Does Sydney ever get the promotion that she is after? Read the book to find out!

I enjoyed reading Stars and Smoke! It was fast paced and made you want to root for Winter and Sydney. I like spy novels, especially teen spy novels, so this hit the spot. 
<u>Film Review</u>

Ennio is a Singing Tribute to a Legendary Film Composer

It's been said that, at the sound of the first note, you will be able to identify an Ennio Morricone score. The duality of the music's boldness and beauty is unmistakable. We also know what will follow is a rich orchestral melody that weaves in and out of emotional landscapes. The prolific composer's influence on music scores in cinema is explored in great detail through Ennio, directed by his longtime collaborator, Cinema Paradiso filmmaker, Giuseppe Tornatore. Paying tribute to one of the industry's most legendary artists, Ennio explores the maestro's career across his iconic film scores, including The Good, The Bad, and the Ugly, Days of Heaven, A Fistful of Dollars, and his Academy Awardwinning work on The Hateful Eight, among hundreds more.

I like to listen to music when I write, and sitting down to begin this review was no different. As I opened Spotify and searched for his name, I was shocked but not surprised to see that the Ennio Morricone profile receives an average of 3.3 million listeners a month.

His most recognizable song, "The Ecstasy of Gold" from The Good, The Bad, and The Ugly shows that it has been streamed nearly 69 million times and counting. These numbers, while staggering, are only a snapshot of the storied career of the Italian maestro.

The documentary runs just over two hours and thirty minutes, and every frame is packed with words of admiration from Ennio's peers, including autobiographical anecdotes from Ennio himself. Fans of his music-making process will revel in the abundance of fascinating interviews with various musicians and directors who have either worked directly with him or were indelibly inspired by him.

Bringing a personal component to the film, Ennio shares stories about his childhood and reminisces about wanting to be a doctor. It was his father who convinced him to study the trumpet instead. It's a scenario you don't hear too often, parents persuading their children's career path towards the arts over medicine. From there, we weave in and out of his repertoire, growing more awestruck with each passing film score.

The film itself is very traditional in its documentary format, fueled by sit-down interviews that bounce from subject to subject. The stories themselves are larger than the formulaic way See Film, page 7

"Currently available treatments are effective tools to treat high cholesterol, but some must be provided by a doctor by injection and can be hard for people to access," said Dr. Christie M. Ballantyne, Professor of Medicine at Baylor College of Medicine.

PCSK9 inhibitors are medications to help treat high cholesterol. Researchers are studying an investigational PCSK9 inhibitor that people can take as a pill once a day by mouth instead of as a shot. Currently, there are clinical studies looking at the safety of this investigational medicine and whether it works. These studies will help researchers better understand whether this medicine can lower LDL-C and the chance of cardiovascular adverse events.

Researchers are looking for people to join these studies. To qualify, you must be aged 18 years or older and you either:

or even competing against each other. The person next to you wants to improve their strength and skills, so it forces you to work just as hard, if not more, to keep up. When you face someone who tries to punch you to hurt you in the ring, but you're able to hold your own, it humbles you and creates a mutual respect for your opponent. It's not just encouraged; it is required to shake your opponent's hand after every encounter in the ring, sometimes even hug him or her, and you always, always, walk across the ring and tell their coach, 'Thank you.' We want to make

Marco's mom worked many years at Bishop Montgomery High School, in the kitchen. Today, she is retired and comes by the gym to help. "Mom is a saint! She does things I don't want to, just keeping the place clean. I



in which they are told, which seems like a conscious choice by Giuseppe Tornatore to not let stylistic filmmaking choices get in the way of the heart and soul of the film. It's clear that this documentary has been in the works for a while; some interviews have a dated, public-access look to them that seems ripe for screening in a museum.

The descriptions given about Ennio Morricone range from "very serious" and "very absorbed" to "a genius" and "a marvel." Waxing poetic about their idol, some interviewees stated that "the God of music speaks through him as if he were possessed" and "His music is... eternal." Before his passing in 2020, Ennio finally won his long overdue Oscar for Quentin Tarantino's 2015 film, The Hateful Eight. At 87 years young in 2016, Ennio Morricone set a new record: the oldest recipient of an Academy Award, proving age is nothing but a number.

Ennio is now playing in Los Angeles at Laemmle Noho with a national expansion and home entertainment release to follow.




